Since its establishment in 1952, Government College Bilaspur has been upholding its motto "TAMSO MAA JYOTRIGMYA" to contribute to society through the pursuit of education and, thus, proudly maintaining its reputation as one of the oldest and amongst the most prestigious colleges of Himachal Pradesh. Nestled below the magnificent Bandla hills on the arresting bank of famous Govind Sagar Lake, the college campus provides ideal surroundings for the quest of knowledge. Past 70 years have witnessed the dedication and firmness with which the college has established a glorious record of academic excellence and has made remarkable achievements in various fields such as sports, cultural and extracurricular activities.

The college is affiliated to Himachal Pradesh University and has been accredited B rating by National Accreditation and Assessment Council (NAAC). The institution offers various undergraduate and postgraduate courses in Arts, Science, Commerce and Vocational streams. Under the self financing scheme, the college is running Bachelor of Computer Application (BCA), Post Graduate Diploma in Computer Application (PGDCA) and B.Sc. in Biotechnology. For the development of the professional skills and for connecting education to the needs of a developing nation, the college also offers BBA, B.Voc. and BTM. The college achieved academic excellence when PG classes in English, Economics and Commerce were started. It is a matter of pride that the college has created opportunities for the pursuit of higher studies in science stream by introducing PG courses in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics in 2021. This initiative attempts to bridge the gap between rural area students and their urban counterparts in the context of higher education. In addition, the institution is also providing distant education through IGNOU study centre.

For this we are indebted to the state government, especially Honourable MLA Sh. Subhash Thakur for leaving no stone unturned in starting 3 PG's in science stream in just one session. The college is also grateful to the state government for covering it under Utkrisht Mahavidyalaya Yojna under which 1 crore has been provided to college for development of new infrastructure and improvement of existing facilities. We are also grateful to the state government for creating a teaching post in public administration in college for the benefit of the students.

The college possesses well equipped and spacious labs in various departments to combine classroom teaching with laboratory experiments. HOSTELS

SC/ST BOYS HOSTEL

[Hostel Warden: Prof. Arun Kumar]

SC/ST Boys' hostel was established on July 6, 2012 in the vicinity of the campus with an intake of 96 students. There are 24 rooms in the Boys Hostel and each room can accommodate a maximum of four students. There are common bathrooms on each floor. At present, only 26 students are residing in the hostel rooms on double sharing basis. Additionally, there is a warden's residence, a common room, two stores, a kitchen with attached store for storing grains, a dining hall and one room for security guard.

GIRLS HOSTEL

[HOSTEL WARDEN: Prof. Sonika Sombal]

The Girls Hostel of the college has 30 rooms in all, out of which 20 rooms are cubicle whereas 10 rooms are available on sharing basis. At present, there are 44 girls who are availing the hostel facility. Due to Covid-19 protocol, only 25 girls could be accommodated in the hostel.

LIBRARY

[Librarian: Sh. Prem Lal, Asst. Librarian: Mrs. Arvindra Chandel]

The college has a well-stocked library with a reading section. It has a subscription of 13 newspapers and 27 magazines. It is equipped with INFLIB-Net technology which provides students an opportunity to access over 1,35,000 e-books and over 6000 e-journals. All students of this college can easily avail the facility of INFLIB-Net N-list for which separate I-codes have been given to the students. A separate cabin of 6 computers and 4 Net books with Wi-Fi connectivity is available in the library. All the books of the library have been entered in the Soul Software 2.0. A book bank facility is also available in the library.

In this session, new books worth INR 109914.00 have been purchased for the students of MSc Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics. Currently, 34883 books on different subjects are available in the library.
