Annual Report

Since its establishment in 1952, Government College Bilaspur has been upholding its motto "TAMSO MAA JYOTIRGMYA" to contribute to society through the pursuit of education and, thus, proudly maintaining its reputation as one of the oldest and amongst the most prestigious colleges of Himachal Pradesh. Nestled below the magnificent Bandla hills on the arresting bank of famous Govind Sagar lake, the college campus provides ideal surroundings for the quest of knowledge. Past 70 years have witnessed the dedication and firmness with which the college has established a glorious record of academic excellence and has made remarkable achievements in various fields such as sports, cultural and extracurricular activities.

The college is affiliated to Himachal Pradesh University and has been accredited B rating by National Accreditation and Assessment Council (NAAC). The institution offers various undergraduate and postgraduate courses in Arts, Science, Commerce and Vocational streams. Under the self-financing scheme, the college is running Bachelor of Computer Application (BCA), Post Graduate Diploma in Computer Application (PGDCA) and B.Sc. in Biotechnology. For the development of the professional skills and for connecting education to the needs of a developing nation, the college also offers BBA, B.Voc. and BTMM. The college achieved academic excellence when PG classes in English, Economics and Commerce were started. It is a matter of pride that the college has created opportunities for the pursuit of higher studies in science stream by introducing PG courses in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics in 2021. This initiative attempts to bridge the gap between rural area students and their urban counterparts in the context of higher education. In addition, the institution is also providing distant education through IGNOU study centre. A teaching post in the subject of Public Administration was created in the year 2021.

The college was covered under Utkrisht Mahavidyalaya Yojna (UMY) for which one crore INR was granted by the state government for development of new infrastructure and improvement of existing facilities. Establishment of five Smart Classrooms and one Language Lab was done under this scheme. The process of digitalisation of college library, still under process, is also covered under UMY.

The college possesses well equipped and spacious labs in various departments to combine classroom teaching with laboratory experiments. The college library is equipped with INFLIBNET facility and maintains a convenient access to print and electronic sources. Regular activities related to Sports, NCC, NSS and Rover & Rangers enhance the vibrance of the institution. Hostel facilities for students and residential quarters for its teaching and non-teaching members are also available in the college. Eco Club, Road Safety Club, Gender Equity Cell, Prehari Club and Red Ribbon Club are active for the integrated development of students. The college hosts a number of inter-college sports and cultural events to provide variant opportunities to students for sharpening their talent and skills in different fields. The college also has Environment Club, Energy Club, Ek Bharat Shresth Bharat Club, different cultural societies and subject related societies to celebrate various notified days and events to educate students throughout the year.

HOSTELS

BOYS HOSTEL

[Hostel Warden: Prof. Ravi Prakash]

Boys hostel was established on July 6, 2012 in the vicinity of the campus with an intake of 90 students. There are 24 rooms in the boys hostel and each room can accommodate a maximum of four students. There are common bathrooms on each floor. At present, only 33 students are residing in the hostel rooms on double sharing basis. Additionally, there is a warden's residence, a common room, two stores, a kitchen with attached store for storing grains, a dining hall and one room for security guard.

GIRLS HOSTEL

Girls hostel has 30 rooms in all out of which 20 rooms are cubicles whereas 10 are rooms available on sharing basis. Though hostel has capacity to accommodate 52 boarders, at present only 42 girls are availing this facility. From the last session the residents of hostel unanimously decided to run the mess on co-operative model and are successfully running it. All the purchases of food items as well as management of the financial matters is done by various committees. And these committees are supervised and guided by the proctors Vishkha (M.Sc 3rd sem Chemistry) and Monika (M.A 3rd sem Economics)

LIBRARY

The college has a well-stocked library with a reading room, computer section, faculty room and circulation section. It has a subscription of 13 newspapers and 25 magazines. It is equipped with N-List technology which provides the students and the staff, an opportunity to access e-books and e-journals. The students of this college can easily avail the facility of N-List for which separate password has been given to all the students. All the books of the library have been entered in the software (SOUL 3.0). The digitalization of the college library is under process. A book bank facility is also available in the library.

In the present session new books, magazines and newspapers worth Rs. 1,30,000 have been purchased.
