### **5.4.1 Upgradation of College Library into a Public Library**

#### **5.4.4 Wall-cum-Bulletin Boards**



Benefits:


1. Display of the college motto, vision, and mission reinforces institutional values and goals among students and stakeholders on a daily basis.
