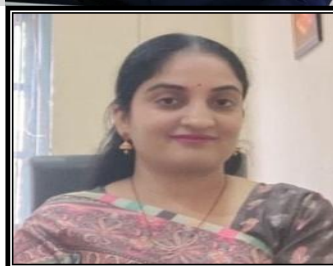

RESERVATION ROSTER FOR ADMISSION as per HPU

- **RESERVATION :**
- Admission shall be subject to the following conditions: A. 15% and 7.5% seats shall be reserved for SC and ST candidates respectively, who have passed their qualifying examination from H P Board of School Education or any other school located within the territorial jurisdiction of Himachal Pradesh from any other Board like CBSE or ICSE etc. B. The remaining 77.5% seats shall be filled as under:
 - 25% of seats for admission shall be open for all the candidates irrespective of the institution from where they have passed their qualifying examination
 - 75% of seats shall be filled out of the candidates who have passed their qualifying examination from H P Board of School Education or any other school located within the territorial jurisdiction of Himachal Pradesh from any other Board like CBSE or ICSE etc. Subject to the following reservations:
 - 5% of the seats shall be reserved for outstanding sportsmen/Women.
 - 5% of seats shall be reserved for outstanding cultural activists.
 - 5% of seats shall be reserved for physically handicapped candidates.
 - Provided that the minimum eligibility for admission to the course in the case of SC/ST will be 5% lower than the eligibility condition for other students.
 - The rules of H P University shall be applicable in the case of above reservations in the college.

Note: There are 10% additional seats reserved for the Economically Weaker Session Category for the admission to BBA and BCA for the academic session 2026-27. If these seats remain vacant than these seats neither be filled with other category nor will carry forward.

Note: For Course BTM 6-28, students will be required to submit their On the Job training report for training undertaken in any travel organization after the completion of the previous (Vth) semester. The detailed work profile, experience and learning will be explained in the report and the report will include a certificate of training form the organization where the training was undertaken. The Report will be evaluated by External/Internal Examiner.

In BTM-29, a Comprehensive Final Viva Voce will be conducted for the students to assess their learning of the whole bachelors program. The Viva will be conducted by External/Internal

Examiner.

ELIGIBILITY FOR PROMOTION TO NEXT SEMESTER

Candidates who have passed 10+2 examination from HPSE Board/CBSE/TCSE or any other examinations considered equivalent to 10+2, by HPU with 50% marks (45% marks for SC/ST Categories) shall be eligible as per HP University rule. 75% seats will be reserved for the candidates who have passed their 10+2 examination from HP Board. The remaining 25% seats will be filled on all India basis and other reservation rules of HP University.

SCHEME OF EXAMINATION

- University Examinations: The BTM course will be spread over in 6 semesters during three years. The final semester exam will be conducted as per the schedule of H.P.U. Shimla.
- House Examination: House examination for the students of BTM will be conducted in each semester and the performance report of candidates will be communicated to the parents of the candidates. It can be have from the college website

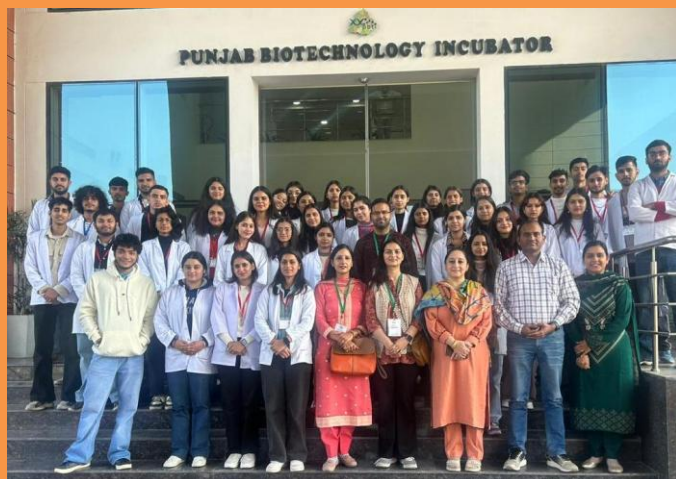
