### **Annual Report**

Since its establishment in 1952, Government College Bilaspur has been upholding its motto "TAMSO MAA JYOTIRGMYA" to contribute to society through the pursuit of education and, thus, proudly maintaining its reputation as one of the oldest and amongst the most prestigious colleges of Himachal Pradesh. Nestled below the magnificent Bandla hills on the arresting bank of famous Govind Sagar Lake, the college campus provides ideal surroundings for the seekers of knowledge. Past 70 years have witnessed the dedication and firmness with which the college has established a glorious record of academic excellence and has made remarkable achievements in various fields such as sports, cultural and extracurricular activities.

The college is affiliated to Himachal Pradesh University and has been accredited B rating by National Accreditation and Assessment Council (NAAC). The institution offers various undergraduate and postgraduate courses in Arts, Science, Commerce and Vocational streams. Under the self-financing scheme, the college is running Bachelor of Computer Application (BCA), Post Graduate Diploma in Computer Application (PGDCA) and B.Sc. in Biotechnology. For the development of the professional skills and for connecting education to the needs of a developing nation, the college also offers BBA, B.Voc and BTTM. The college achieved academic excellence with the commencement of PG classes in English, Economics and Commerce. #### **BOYS HOSTEL**

Boys hostel invites the hostelers to enjoy their sojourn in a home away from home in the most fruitful and memorable way. Situated within the precincts of the college, boys hostel is functional since 2012. Hostel building with 24 ventilated and spacious rooms, has a capacity to accommodate 96 students. Additionally, there is a warden's residence, a common room, two stores, a kitchen with attached store, a dining hall and one room for security guard. In the current session, 32 students are residing in the hostel on double sharing basis. With the personal attention and care given to the boarders by the respected Chair Dr. P.S Kutwal, hostel authorities consistently strive to develop life skills, positive attitude, leadership qualities along with a sense of belongingness, discipline, duty and commitment among boarders. Hostel provides safe, secure and academically conducive ambience with affordable accommodation, 24x7 camera surveillance and hygienic as well as nutritious food at nominal rates. A reading room has been developed in the hostel in 2024 to foster study environment.

### **GIRLS HOSTEL**

Girls hostel has 30 rooms in all, out of which 20 rooms are cubicles whereas 10 rooms are available on sharing basis. The hostel has a capacity to accommodate 52 boarders, at present 42 girls are availing the facility. The residents of the hostel are successfully running mess on cooperative model managed by various committees and supervised by the proctors Anjali (M.Sc 4th sem Chemistry) and Deksha (M.Sc 4th sem Chemistry). A reading room has been developed in the hostel in 2024 in the larger interest of the students.

### **LIBRARY**

The college has a well stocked library, named Dr. Bhim Rao Ambedkar Library, with a reading room, circulation section, computer and periodical cum faculty section. Our institution offers Online Public Access to Catalogue (OPAC) and resources to explore the library anytime and anywhere. Books are issued to students through Bar-coded Identity Cards and instantaneously they get a circulation message through e-mail. College Library is equipped with NList and NDLI which provide the students and staff an opportunity to access E-Books and E-Journals. Book Bank facility is also available in the library. College library has a subscription of 14 newspapers, 29 magazines and 05 journals. In the present session new books, newspapers, journals and magazines worth Rs. 100000 have been purchased. All the books of library have been entered in SOUL 3.0.

- 5. MOUs signed with different schools: GSSS Chandpur, GSSS Kothipura, GSSS Raghunathpura, GSSS Kandrour, GSSS (Girls) Bilaspur and GSS (Boys) Bilaspur.
- 6. To ensure efficient storage and record keeping, two cabins for office storage & record have been set up. A separate cabin for chowkidar is also established.
- 7. The college encouraged student participation in sports and cultural activities by providing diverse opportunities for involvement, contributing in their holistic development.
- 8. Educational trips were organized for students of different streams.
- 9. The college conducted meetings with the staff to work upon the gaps to improve NAAC grade.
- 10. To ensure student safety, mobility and accessibility between new and old campus, construction of a covered (monkey resistant) walkway, linking new and old campus is in progress.
- 11. A silence zone has been created outside the library, with aluminium enclosure around the entrance to ensure a quiet environment conducive to reading and study.
- 12. A daycare room has been established to provide a dedicated space for childcare services.
- 13. Student parking facility is currently under progress.
- 14. The cleanliness of the college is maintained by 26 different departments on regular basis.
- 15. The repair and renovation of two rooms adjoining chemistry department is underway.
- 16. Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR) for the session 2023-24 has been submitted to NAAC.
- 17. One day workshop titled 'Office Procedures and Other Rules for Capacity Building' was organised on 10 March 2025.
